Formerly known on the Modern Jewish Calendar as the month of Tammuz. Tammuz is the Babylonian sun god (Nimrod reincarnated) who was born on Dec 25th and died in the 4th month. The Jewish fast of the 4th month originated as the time of "weeping for Tammuz" (Ezekiel 8). Constantine moved the 40 days of "weeping" on the "Christian" calendar to be the 40 days preceding the reincarnation of Tammuz's mother, Semiramis, as "Easter". The fast of Tammuz was then renamed "Lent" which was preceded by the traditional glutinous sex orgy which became known as "Mardi Gras".
